

## **Archery Range Rules at NORVA:**

1. Crossbows are not allowed at NORVA.
2. No hunting on club property.
3. Anyone may call a CEASE FIRE if an unsafe condition is observed. This includes members, guests and minors. If a CEASE FIRE is called, the entire range must draw down, un-nock arrows and convene.
4. No Broadheads may be shot or be on your person on the 3D or Field ranges at any time.
5. Broadheads (except TOXIC type) may be shot on the broadhead range.
6. All members and guests must log in and out of the logbook in the clubhouse.
7. Anyone under age of 18 years of age must have adult supervision.
8. Guest policy will coincide with NORVA rules: Each guest must sign a waiver & all guests must be supervised. If you bring a pet, supervision and cleanup is your responsibility.
9. Shoot only at the targets.
10. Never shoot up in the air or in any direction that might destroy property or endanger a life.
11. Never draw or shoot a bow when there is someone between you and the target.
12. Always be sure the area behind your target is clear.
13. Do not shoot across lanes on the practice ranges. Only shoot at the target directly in front of you. For Example- do not shoot the 15 or 25 yard targets when you are in line with the 20 yard target.
14. Never allow anyone to retrieve arrows until all the arrows have been shot and range is COLD.
15. When retrieving arrows from behind the target, keep one person in front of the target to alert upcoming archers of your presence.
16. Check your equipment prior to shooting – some examples include:
  - Frayed bow strings
  - Cracked bow limbs
  - Missing C-clips on your cam axles
  - Cracked or bent arrows (test by flexing them if they are carbon arrows)
  - Heat / cold stress if you left your equipment in your car for an extended time
  - Worn D-loops
  - Loose or broken nocks
  - Examine and Test your release
17. Place any found arrows in the clubhouse to be claimed by their rightful owner.
18. Police the range at all times and leave it in better condition than when you arrived. This includes the grounds, clubhouse and yes - emptying trash cans in the dumpster occasionally.
19. Please report all defects or unsafe conditions immediately to any Club Officer via email & chalkboard.
20. Before vacating the premises, all persons must sign out in the log book, check lights, water, etc. and make sure all windows, doors, and gates are secure. Ensure lock combinations are scrambled.
21. Quiver tags must be displayed while using the archery ranges except during sanctioned events.
22. Anyone without a quiver tag can be challenged by any member and be asked to leave. A current membership card is acceptable identification, but each member is required to display a quiver tag and the situation should be rectified as soon as possible.
